As an exchange student at the USM, you have to have reached adequate Spanish language skills. During your exchange you will be following courses in Spanish and are expected to participate actively in class discussions and group work. You must also be able to write academic papers and take written exams.

You should therefore show the following level of Spanish, which corresponds to an A2 level according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Language. You can:

- Understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate personal relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment).
- Communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters.
- Write short and simple messages.
- Describe in simple terms aspects of your background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need.
